Mr Paul McArthur MB BS, FRCSEd, PhD, FRCS (Plast) is a highly experienced Consultant Plastic and Hand Surgeon practising in the Northwest of England, with NHS appointments at the Mersey Regional Plastic Surgery Unit (Whiston Hospital) and Alder Hey Children's Hospital in Liverpool. He specialises in congenital hand surgery and upper limb reconstruction, managing both paediatric and adult conditions such as nerve injuries, cerebral palsy-related deformities and soft-tissue disorders, and complex reconstructive cases across the upper limb.

Mr McArthur received his medical degree from Newcastle University (1990), followed by doctoral research at the University of Sheffield (PhD) and advanced plastic and hand surgery training, including fellowships in Manchester and North Carolina, USA. He was appointed consultant in 2003 and has since led service delivery in hand and reconstructive surgery with a commitment to multidisciplinary care pathways.

An active contributor to professional education and governance, Mr McArthur has served in leadership roles within the British Association of Plastic, Reconstructive and Aesthetic Surgeons (BAPRAS) — including Council membership and as President — and has been involved with the Intercollegiate Specialty Examination Board for Plastic Surgery as an examiner and FRCS(Plast) assessor. His clinical and academic work underscores a dedication to advancing reconstructive practice and training excellence nationally and internationally.

Mr Christopher J. Lewis MBBS (Hons), MSc (Burn Care), PhD, FRCS (Plast) is a Consultant Plastic, Burn and Reconstructive Surgeon at the Northern Regional Burn Centre, based at the Royal Victoria Infirmary in Newcastle upon Tyne. He specialises in emergency burn care, burn reconstruction, scar management, laser therapy for scars and vascular anomalies, and multidisciplinary reconstructive surgery for both adults and children.

After graduating with Honours from Imperial College London, he completed higher specialist plastic surgery training in the North East of England and undertook a burn and laser fellowship at the State Burn Service of Western Australia. He holds a Master's in Burn Care with Distinction and a PhD in stem cell biology and wound healing, underlining his strong academic and research background.

Mr Lewis leads the clinical laser service at the Royal Victoria Infirmary and is Clinical Lead for Burn Research at the Northern Regional Burn Centre, holding competitive research grants and participating in national multicentre studies on burn care and scar modulation. He serves as Chair of the Burns Special Interest Advisory Group (BAPRAS), contributes extensively to published literature and national teaching, and is actively involved in training surgical registrars and multidisciplinary teams in advanced burn and reconstructive care. He is also the Deputy Editor for the JPRAS and on the BFIRST committee to support plastic surgery development low to medium income countries (LMICs).

His clinical expertise spans microsurgery, limb reconstruction, breast reconstruction, skin cancer surgery and aesthetic body procedures.

After completing his initial medical and surgical training in Alexandria, Egypt, Mr Emam undertook further UK clinical training in Bristol, where he completed two renowned postgraduate fellowships in breast reconstruction and limb reconstruction, focused on advanced microsurgical and complex defect management. In his NHS practice, he is a key member of the Welsh Centre for Burns & Plastic Surgery, contributing significantly to orthoplastic pathways and complex tumour/soft-tissue reconstruction, and managing both trauma-related limb salvage and elective reconstructive procedures.

Mr Emam is actively involved in education and training, regularly presenting at national and international surgical meetings and participating as faculty on multiple plastic surgery courses. His published work in peer-reviewed journals spans reconstruction, microsurgical technique, and outcomes research.
